# Canteen Management Policy

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that the canteen is a service that will:

- Provide members and their guests the option to purchase food, snacks and beverages at club events
- Function as an efficient business enterprise.
- Demonstrate high standards of food safety and hygiene in relation to the preparation, storage and serving of food that is consistent with the national Australia New Zealand Food Standards (Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) website)
- Maintain the canteens registration with the City of Greater Bendigo and operate within its regulations.

# **Trading Hours**

The canteen will be open from 10:30 to 2:20 on Saturday Race Days.

In consultation with the Canteen Manager, the canteen will be available for special events (regattas etc) approved by the General Committee.

### Insurance

• The Canteen Manager and volunteers are covered by the Club's insurance policies.

#### General Committee Responsibilities

- Appointing the Canteen Manager
- Oversight of the Canteen Manager and the canteen
- The provision of any capital equipment
- Maintenance and replacement of equipment
- Provision of Utilities (Gas, Electricity, Water and Internet)
- Payment of Licence Fees
- A monthly financial report outlining both the canteen's income and expenditure.

#### Canteen Manager Responsibilities

- The Food Handling Program
- Safe food handling procedures
- Cleanliness and presentation of the canteen
- Menu selection
- Provision of stock

- Appropriate safe food and personal hygiene training
- Maintaining the Cub's Registration with the City of Greater Bendigo
- Food Safety Supervisor's certification
- Training of volunteers in-line with their duties
- Management of volunteer staff

#### Volunteers

### Responsibilities:

- Undertake the training provided by Do Food Safely (dofoodsafely.health.vic.gov.au ) and supply the Canteen Manager with a copy their DofoodSafely Certificate
- Attend a canteen orientation program

While on duty volunteers will be supplied with a clean pocket-less apron, and must wear closed footwear.

Volunteers are entitled to lunch and afternoon tea.
